Requirements for Registration and Updating for use of Client Services at the House of Compassion

These are required by the House of Compassion as requirements for the following services: utility assistance (electric, gas, water), prescription assistance, use the Supply Closet, government ID, birth certificates, tuition assistance for ASL Iowa Valley, GED tuition assistance, bus tickets to for employment related activities and the JobPath program.

Services are covered up to \$100 for individuals and \$150 per household per calendar year.

One document from each category is required:

1. Current photo ID
2. Proof of residency in Marshall County (any one of the following documents):
 - a. Utility Bill with address and name of the individual applying
 - b. Copy of lease
 - c. Copy of rental agreement
 - d. A letter addressed to you with a Marshall County address
 - i. If you are experiencing homelessness, please use our Postal Service and have mail sent to our address as proof of homelessness. If you need us to send the letter, please let us know.
3. Proof of Income from everyone in the household above the age of 18 (any one of the following documents per household members above the age of 18):
 - a. Paycheck stubs
 - b. Letter on company letterhead showing weekly/monthly salary from HR department
 - c. If you do not have a current income, and have been living somewhere for more than 6 months, please bring a letter written by who has been responsible for the rent and utilities

Updating, registration, and utility assistance cannot be completed without the above listed documents.
